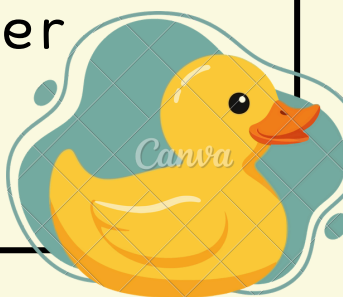
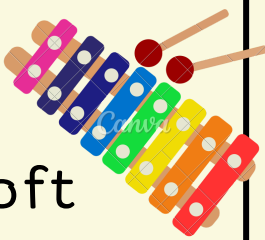
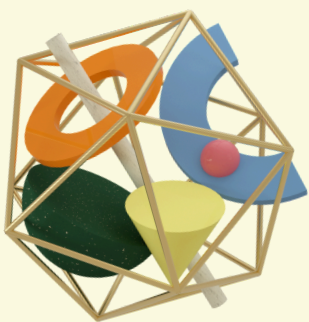

Infants



- Toys to shake or squeeze - rattles, large rings, squeeze toys, textured and soft balls
- Soft books - vinyl or board books, nursery rhymes and poems, crinkly or fabric books
- Visual play - black and white or bright hanging toys for cots and prams, unbreakable mirrors, light-up toys
- Calming resources - baby wraps, soft toys, white noise machines
- Teething toys - safe teethers and soothing rings
- Musical experiences - music boxes, simple musical toys
- Sensory items - play gyms, spinner toys, massage toys, sensory boards, water sensory pads
- Feeding support - sippy cups
- Cot mobiles - musical mobiles, black and white mobiles
- Pram and cot toys
- White noise machine, massage toys, spinner toys, sensory boards, water sensory pad

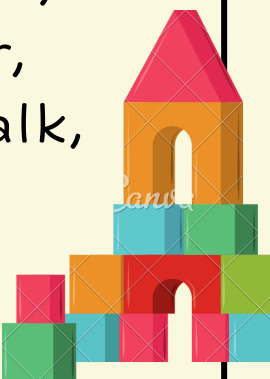


- Pretend and imaginative play - wooden/soft blocks, vehicles, construction sets, animals, tea sets, dolls with accessories, dress-ups, play food, sand and water toys, posting boxes
- Creative resources - large crayons, markers, paintbrushes, finger paints, drawing paper, toddler-safe scissors, chalkboards and chalk, stickers
- Books - board books with real-life images, picture books, musical books
- Problem-solving play - shape sorters, snap-together blocks, wooden puzzles (4-12 pieces), sorting games, cause and effect toys, buckles, buttons, zips, latches

Toddlers



- Movement and gross motor toys - push/pull toys, balls (all sizes), stacking and nesting toys, toys that light up or pop up, cars and trucks
- Music - toddler-friendly musical instruments
- Heuristic and sensory play - small world play (farm, wild, and sea animals), tactile toys, water and sand play items
- Feeding tools - bowls and spoons for self-feeding
- Other - fidget spinners, playdough food sets, dolls, dress-ups, storybooks, strong push trolleys
- Heuristic play resources and cause and effect toys



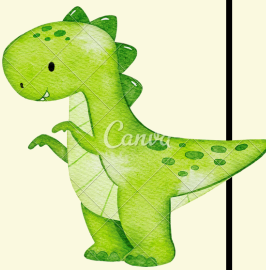

- Pretend and social play - family sets, toy phones, strollers, dress-ups, dolls (including Barbie, Moana, Frozen), puppets, new soft toys, superheroes like Spiderman and Batman, kitchen sets, doctor play sets, dinosaurs, farm/zoo/sea creatures
- Building and construction - Lego, Duplo, Mobilo, magnetic tiles, construction vehicles
- Creative resources - small and large crayons/markers/paintbrushes, finger paints, modelling clay, glue, coloured paper, drawing books, stickers, art tools
- Books - picture books, musical books, cultural books (belonging, identity, diversity)
- Sensory play - kinetic sand, slime, poppets, playdough sets and tools
- Music - child-sized musical instruments
- Problem-solving and fine motor - puzzles (up to 60 pieces), large pegboards, toys with switches, knobs, lids
- Games - beginner board and card games
- Other - Cocomelon toys, magnetic blocks, activity books with favourite characters



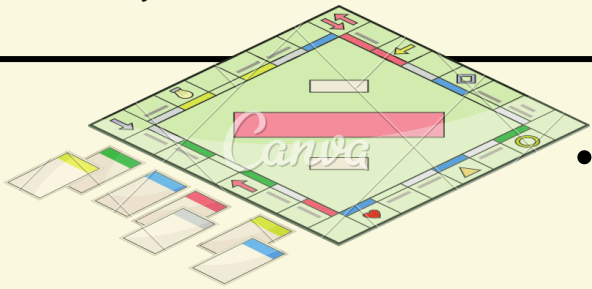

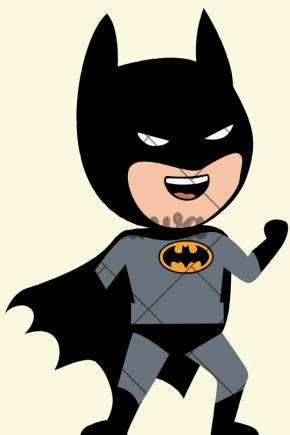

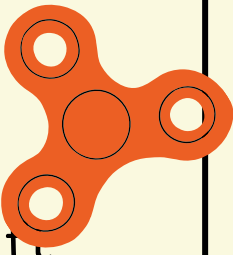

- Travel card games and fancy soap



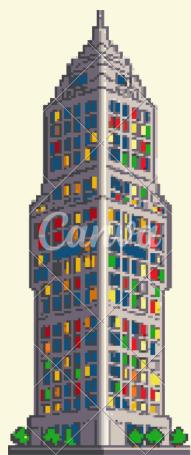
